# SCHEDULE 'A' OLYMPIC SELECTION CRITERIA

SPORT: CYCLING - ROAD

### OLYMPIC SELECTION CRITERIA [1, 2] 1. QUALIFYING SPORT SPECIFIC PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

Between July 1, 2002 and July 11, 2004, athletes achieving the following absolute results in an event at an International Cycling Union (UCI) sanctioned competition, will be eligible for selection to the Olympic Team, subject to Schedules 'B' and 'C' attached.

Road Race Men Top-10 overall or equal time three (3) times in races with

a category of 1.3 or 2.3 or better (1 point each time);

OR

Top-10 overall or equal time six (6) times in races with a category of 1.5 or 2.5 or better (0.5 points each time);

OR

Any combination of points earned above equal to or

better than a minimum total of three (3) points.

Road Race Women Top-8 overall or equal time three (3) times in World Cups

and races with a category of 1.9.1 or 2.9.1 or better

#### OLYMPIC SELECTION CRITERIA [1] 2. QUALIFYING RANK AT THE 2003 ROAD WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Athletes achieving the following rankings at the 2003 World Road Championships, modified to Olympic entry regulations, will be eligible for selection to the Olympic Team subject to Schedules 'B' and 'C' attached.

Road Race Men Top-12 or equal time

Road Race Women Top-12 or equal time

- [1] Meeting the Olympic Selection Criteria does not guarantee selection to the Olympic Team (see paragraph 6b of the COC/NSF Team Selection Agreement);
- [2] All qualifying criteria must be achieved within the same event.
