



# COVID-19 PROTOCOLS & RISK MITIGATIONS ENFORCED FOR THE 2022 CANADIAN TRACK CHAMPIONSHIPS

April 8-10, 2022

## DAILY HEALTH SCREENING

All participants of the 2022 Canadian Track Championships (athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, event staff, media) are required to complete a daily COVID-19 self-screening questionnaire before arriving on-site via [HealthQ](#), which will also require name and contact information for contact tracing purposes. If a participant has failed their daily health screening, they will see a Red Screen and should not enter the facility. The information and next steps will be instructed from there and emailed to the participant and the Odyssey Medical Health & Safety Team.

## MASK MANDATE & PHYSICAL DISTANCING

All participants (athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, event staff, media) **in the infield** are required to wear a mask (covering their nose and mouth) at all times, with the following exceptions:

- When any person is eating or drinking;
- Athletes who are going up to the track to race; or
- Athletes that are riding on their rollers or trainers.

Knowing that physical distancing of 2m cannot be respected at all times, we do ask that an effort be made as much as possible. If athletes and/or coaches are interacting with officials, volunteers, or event staff on the infield, please stay masked and distanced.

## SPECTATORS

Spectators will not have access to the infield at any point and must remain on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the velodrome. Please respect physical distancing and avoid the first few rows of seating near the track.

## VOLUNTEER AREA

The volunteer area will be in the "Sport D". This will hold the food for all officials, volunteers, and event staff. Individual hand sanitizers, masks and gloves will be readily available.

## CLEANING PROCEDURES & SANITIZING STATIONS

There will be frequent cleaning of high-touch surfaces. Various sanitizing stations will be located throughout the venue and in the infield at key locations:

- Entrance to the track (2)
- Commissaire Platform
- Sport Information Desk (*disposable masks and gloves will be readily available if needed*)
- Volunteer Area
- Bike Check
- Podium

## TEAM PITS & ROLLERS/TRAINERS SET UP

Team pits will be placed into single rows and spread throughout the infield, allowing for maximized space and flow. No pits will be placed back-to-back with another, allowing the team from that pit to set up rollers and trainers directly behind their dedicated pit.

## AWARDS CEREMONIES

All awards ceremonies will be conducted in a *self-serve* manner. Masked event staff will place the medals and jersey on the table beside the podium (left side when looking at the podium). The masked athletes will grab their award from the table and proceed onto the podium. Masks can be removed quickly for a podium picture. After pictures have been taken, athletes are to put their masks back on and exit the podium to their left-hand side while event staff re-stock the table for the next ceremony.

Either stanchions or tape will be marked on the ground to allow a clear visual for event photographers to capture each podium presentation. Please respect this space for accredited media only.

**Any participant that does not comply with these rules will first be asked to correct their behaviour. A second verbal warning will be given before being asked to leave the event if the behaviour persists. Riders will lose their race bibs and not be allowed to start.**
